Dear Parent/Carer,

Unfortunately Covid cases are still rising in our area and this is having an impact in our school. We have had further cases reported to us and, following more talks with Public Health we have been advised to input further measures to try and combat the rise in numbers.

As of Thursday, there will be no more Breakfast Club until January. Although the children sit in individual class groups they are all together in the hall, and we been advised to stop this. Unfortunately we do not have capacity to run the club in individual classrooms.

Christmas plays will now be performed virtually as we have been advised against having all but essential visitors and parents in school. Messages will be sent via Dojo from class teachers in the coming days to ensure you are happy for your children to be filmed and shared.

We will be running the Christmas Fair virtually. Photographs of any items to sell will be posted on Dojo along with prices. The children will be making lots of goodies and crafts and these will also be available. More information will follow over the next few days.

If cases continue to rise then unfortunately we will have to cancel the school trip to the Pantomime. This is obviously a big event with not just our school attending and we have already been told by Public Health that if numbers do increase the trip will be in jeopardy.

Please can I ask again that if you have any positive case in your family that you let us know and, if possible, you take your child for a PCR test. At the very least we would like you to do a LFT if you have family cases. All staff in school are testing every day.

Thank you for your patience and understanding at this time. We had hoped for normality this year, and we will try and keep things as normal as possible for the children but there are certainly challenges ahead for us!
