Dear Parent/Carer

We are busy in school getting everything ready for all the children returning to school next Monday. You have already received information regarding times for drop off and pick up and all the other routines will be as they were before Christmas.

Children will only need to bring with them packed lunch, water bottle and reading book. Pencil cases and other stationery or books do not need to be brought in. On P.E. days the children should come in P.E. kit and be prepared to do this lesson outside. Your child's class teacher will confirm what days P.E. will be taught via Class Dojo.

The children will continue to be in their class bubbles – this is following government guidance – and they will not be mixing with other classes during the day. Until further notice there will be no whole school assemblies and lunches will continue to be eaten in classrooms.

As always, the safety of your children and our staff are my main priority and we will continue to do everything we can to make sure that the school operates in a Covid secure way.

Could you please ensure your children do not come to the school gates to meet their friends at home time – we are doing everything we are asked to in school to ensure that bubbles do not mix and on Friday afternoon there were quite a few children waiting outside the gates for school to finish. Please also ensure that social distancing continues to take place if you at the park with your children. Although the government are slowly lifting restrictions over the next few months this does not mean that Covid-19 has gone away and I really would ask that you continue to follow the guidance in the hope that we can all get back to normality sooner rather than later.
