Now the weather is changing please ensure your children are dressed in clothing that will keep them warm in school. Although we will obviously have the heating on in school when needed, we are being advised to make sure all classrooms are well ventilated and have windows open. An extra layer such as a vest or plain t-shirt under their school tops and possibly tights instead of socks for the girls will help to keep them that bit warmer. Also, please ensure that your child brings a coat with them every day as we will try our best to get them outside for playtimes.

We will shortly be sending out a letter regarding parent's appointments for after half term. This year these will be done by phone call. They will be booked in the similar way that appointments have previously been made. Each class will have a set day and time slots and you will be able to select the most suitable for you.

We are still hoping to do some fundraising for Macmillan this term. There are several ideas that we are looking at in order to ensure we do this in a safe manner. Unfortunately we won't be able to have parents on site for a coffee morning but we are planning on doing something that all the children can get involved in.



Birthdays are always an exciting time for children. Please can we ask that if you wish to send any treats in with your children, they are in individual packets and are brought into school at least 72hrs before so that we can store them in isolation, ready to give out safely on the day. We cannot accept any large cakes or anything which isn't in original sealed packaging and individual wrappers, please do not take them out of the multipack packaging. If you don't wish your child to receive any treats please email the school office. We trust you understand our reasons behind this.



With the weather becoming more unsettled, and the children doing P.E. outside as much as possible, it may be useful for them to have some jogging trousers or a tracksuit to wear when they are in the classroom. Ideally they should be black and something the children can either keep on for P.E. or wear their shorts under so that they do not need to 'change' for P.E.

Hometime seems to be going really well – a huge thank you to you all for working with us on this. Please continue to social distance at the gate and remember the Rule of 6. Also, a reminder that it should only be 1 parent from each household collecting children.
