Dear Parent/Carer

I wrote to all parents recently to invite nominations for the vacancy for a parent governor. There has been a good response and there are two candidates for one post. This means that we must now hold a ballot. Information about those standing for election is attached.

A ballot paper is detailed below. Each family has one ballot paper irrespective of the number of children at school. Ballot papers must be returned to school no later than 15th March 2019.

The ballot papers will be counted at 12.00 noon on 18th March 2019. Candidates are invited to attend the opening of the ballot box and subsequent count. An independent scrutineer, who will be a parent of a child at the school not seeking election, will be present during the count.

The parent polling the highest number of votes will be declared duly elected to the governing body and you will be notified of the result in due course.
